A simple guide to open, customize, and export your wedding invitation template in Canva.

OPEN YOUR BUSINESS CARD TEMPLATE

Open the Canva template below, create your own copy, and personalize it for your wedding.

Before you start

You need a Canva account to edit the template. A free Canva account is sufficient unless you replace elements with Canva Pro content.

QUICK NOTE

This PDF is your access guide. Keep it for future reference. The Canva template link above should open a copy of the design so you can edit your own version without changing the original.

Open and edit in Canva

The template is designed to be easy to customize. Keep the refined editorial structure and only change what supports your own wedding details.

1 Open the template

Click the template link on page 1. Canva will open the design in your browser or app.

2 Create your own copy

Choose "Use template" or the equivalent Canva option when prompted. This keeps the original template unchanged.

3 Replace the sample text

Update the couple names, wedding date, venue, city, and invitation wording with your own information.

4 Keep the hierarchy

Use the existing type sizes, spacing, alignment, and section order as your baseline. Avoid adding too many decorative elements.

5 Check every detail

Remove unused sample content and carefully verify names, date, time, venue, city, spelling, and punctuation before exporting.

TIP

For the cleanest result, keep the design minimal. If your wording feels crowded, shorten the copy before reducing the font size or squeezing the spacing.

Make it yours, then download

Customize carefully, then export a final file that stays sharp, balanced, and ready for print or digital sharing.

EDITING CHECKLIST

- ☐ Replace the couple names and invitation wording
- ☐ Confirm the wedding date, time, venue, and city
- ☐ Keep spacing and alignment consistent
- ☐ Customize fonts or colors only when needed
- ☐ Remove all unused sample text
- ☐ Proofread names, spelling, and punctuation

DOWNLOAD SETTINGS

PDF Print

Best for professional or home printing and maximum PDF quality.

PDF Standard

Useful for digital sharing, email, and smaller file sizes.

PNG

Useful for sending a digital preview or sharing the invitation as an image.

How to download from Canva

1 Select Share, then Download

Canva interface labels may change slightly, but the download option is normally available from the Share menu.

2 Choose your file type

Choose PDF Print for printing. Use PDF Standard or PNG when you mainly plan to share the invitation digitally.

3 Download and review

Open the exported file and check the page size, text, spacing, and overall alignment before printing or sharing it.
