A simple guide to open, customize, and export your resume template in Canva.

CHOOSE YOUR TEMPLATE SIZE

Use the version that matches the document size requested by your employer or region. You can edit both versions in Canva.

Before you start

You need a Canva account to edit the template. A free Canva account is sufficient unless you replace elements with Canva Pro content.

QUICK NOTE

This PDF is your access guide. Keep it for future reference. The Canva template links above open a copy of the design so you can edit your own version.

Open and edit in Canva

The template is designed to be easy to customize. Keep the structure clean and only change what supports your own information.

1 Open your preferred size

Click the US Letter or A4 link on page 1. Canva will open the template in your browser or app.

2 Create your own copy

Choose "Use template" or the equivalent Canva option when prompted. This keeps the original template unchanged.

3 Replace the sample text

Update the name, contact details, summary, experience, education, skills, and other sample information with your own.

4 Keep the hierarchy

Use the existing text sizes, spacing, alignment, and section order as your baseline. Avoid adding too many styles or extra decorative elements.

5 Check every section

Remove unused sample content and make sure dates, job titles, links, and contact details are accurate before exporting.

TIP

For the cleanest result, keep your resume to one page when your experience allows it. If you need more space, duplicate the page and keep the same typography and spacing system.

Make it yours, then download

Customize carefully, then export a final file that stays sharp and easy to read.

EDITING CHECKLIST

- ☐ Use your real name and contact details
- ☐ Keep body text concise and scannable
- ☐ Use consistent date formatting
- ☐ Keep bullets short and achievement-focused
- ☐ Delete unused sections instead of leaving blanks
- ☐ Proofread spelling, links, and punctuation

DOWNLOAD SETTINGS

PDF Print

Best for applications, printing, and for email or online upload.

PDF Standard

Useful when you need a smaller file for email or online upload.

PNG

Use only when a platform specifically asks for an image file.

How to download from Canva

1

Select Share, then Download

Canva interface labels may change slightly, but the download option is normally available from the Share menu.

2

Choose your file type

For most resume applications, choose PDF Print or PDF Standard.

3

Download and review

Open the exported file and check the page size, text, spacing, and clickable links before sending it.
